INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Employee should visit or call Ann Gray Ray, Jennifer Sierson, or Laura Stroud at the Iredell County Tax Collector's Office to determine the correct property tax account number to which your payments will be applied.
2. Sign the form, make a copy for your records, and submit the original to the Iredell County Tax Collector's Office. The Tax Collector's Office will submit the form to the Iredell County Human Resources Office.
